The educational goal of the Consortium is to present one to three areas of clinical dermatology at each meeting. Topics are selected by the Steering Committee from the list of the Core Curriculum. It is planned to cover the complete curriculum in about six years and then recycle. After selection of each broad topic, speakers are carefully chosen for each subject. These speakers are not necessarily recognized for their expertise in their topic, but must reside in the area encompassed by the Consortium and are known to be effective and enthusiastic teachers.

**CLINICAL MEETING:** All Consortium meetings are held in conjunction with presentation of patients at a clinical meeting. Patients will be presented beginning at 8:30 AM in the Sydenstricker Clinic at the Medical College of Georgia. Dr. Harold O. Perry of the Mayo Clinic will be moderator of the clinical discussions which will be held in the Large Auditorium of the Education Center, MCG. Dr. James L. O'Quinn will be the presenter and discussor of the histopathologic findings. Bus transportation from the Augusta Hilton will be available shortly after 8:00 AM for the trip to MCG. Buses will also be available for return to the hotel after the clinical meeting.

**RECEPTION and DINNER:** A reception and dinner is planned for Saturday evening at the Garden Center (historic Old Medical College Building), sponsored by the Carolinas-Virginia Dermatologic Society and the local hosts.

**CREDIT:** The American Academy of Dermatology, as an organization accredited for Continuing Medical Education, certifies that participation in the Consortium Program plus the Clinical Meeting at MCG qualifies for 13 hours of Category 1 AE with the American Academy of Dermatology toward their Continuing Medical Education Award and toward the Physician's Recognition Award of the American Medical Association. For the Academy Award, 1 AE will count toward the 30 special credits required.

**REGISTRATION:** Separate registrations are required for the Consortium Meeting (Friday and Saturday) and the Clinical Meeting (Sunday). Please complete the registration form and enclose the appropriate check or checks. For the Consortium Meeting and the special events make the check payable to the SE CONSORTIUM FOR CME. For the Clinical Meeting and dinner make the check payable to MCG Department of Dermatology. Residents in training may attend the Consortium for CME and the Clinical Meeting at no charge except for (1) a \$5.00 fee at the door if they desire a notebook of handouts which is provided by the Consortium for CME (2) the \$25.00 per person charge for the reception and dinner (3) appropriate registration fees for social activities.
