# General Information

**THE NINTH SOUTHEASTERN CONSORTIUM** for Continuing Medical Education in Dermatology will be held at Duke University Medical Center in Durham, N.C. on Friday, Saturday and Sunday, October 4-6. The educational goal of the Consortium is to update one to two areas of clinical dermatology at each meeting. Topics are selected by the Steering Committee from the list of the Core Curriculum and rotate every year among the participating institutions. The complete curriculum is recycled every eight years. After selection of each broad topic, speakers are carefully chosen for each subject. Emphasis is put on choosing effective and enthusiastic teachers from the area encompassed by the Consortium.

**THE TOPIC THIS YEAR:** "Update on Eczematous and Papulosquamous Disorders"

**MEETING PLACE:** Duke University Medical Center, Durham, North Carolina.

**HERBERT Z. LUND LECTURESHIP:** Dr. Gerald G. Krueger, Chief of Dermatology at the University of Utah Medical Center and a noted researcher in psoriasis, will give the Herbert Z. Lund lecture on "The Pathogenesis of Psoriasis."

**CLINICAL MEETING:** All Consortium meetings are held in conjunction with the presentation of patients at a clinical meeting. Patients will be presented Sunday, October 6, beginning at 8:30 AM in the Dermatology Clinic at Duke University Medical Center. Dr. Gerald G. Krueger will be the moderator of the clinical discussions to be held in the Medical Center Auditorium, Duke University Medical Center following patient presentations. Dr. Robin T. Vollmer will discuss the histopathologic findings.

**TRANSPORTATION:** Transportation will be provided from the Sheraton University Center to the Consortium and Clinical meetings and will be available one-half hour before the start of the various programs.

**CREDIT:** The American Academy of Dermatology, as an organization accredited for Continuing Medical Education, certifies that participation in the Consortium Program plus the Clinical Meeting at DUMC qualifies for 13 hours of Category 1 AE with the American Academy of Dermatology toward their Continuing Medical Education Award and toward the Physician's Recognition Award.

**RECEPTION AND DINNER:** A reception and dinner is planned for Saturday evening at the Sheraton University Center.

**REGISTRATION:** Separate registrations are required for the Consortium Meeting (Friday and Saturday), the Reception and Banquet, and the Sunday Clinical Meeting. Residents in training may attend the Consortium for CME and the Clinical Meeting at no charge except for (1) the \$25.00 per person charge for the reception and dinner and (2) appropriate registration fees for social activities.
