The Fifteenth Southeastern Consortium for Continuing Medical Education in Dermatology will be held in Augusta, Georgia on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday, September 27-29, 1991. It will be hosted by the Department of Dermatology at the Medical College of Georgia and Eisenhower Army Medical Center, Fort Gordon, Georgia. The educational goal of the Consortium is to update one or two areas of clinical dermatology at each meeting. These topics are selected from a core curriculum, and the meeting rotates every year among the participating institutions. The goal is to recycle the complete curriculum every eight years. Emphasis is placed on choosing effective and enthusiastic speakers from the region encompassed by the Consortium.

The Topics This Year:

1. "Mucous Membrane Disorders"
2. "Inflammatory Skin Disorders"

Meeting Place and Overview:

The meeting is hosted this year by the Department of Dermatology at the Medical College of Georgia and the Section of Dermatology from Eisenhower Army Medical Center. The Friday and Saturday sessions will be held at the Alumni Center on 15th Street at the Medical College of Georgia in Augusta. On Sunday morning, September 29, 1991, a clinical meeting consisting of patient presentations will begin at 8:30 a.m. in the Medical College of Georgia Faculty Clinic on Harper Street. The exact location will be announced and a map posted at the meeting. At 10:00 a.m. a discussion of the patients will begin at the Alumni Center.

Herbert Z. Lund Lectureship:

Dr. Rebecca Buckley, Professor of Allergy and Immunology, Duke University School of Medicine will present the Herbert Z. Lund Lecture on "Regulation of IgE Synthesis in Eczema and Other Atopic Disorders" on Saturday morning at 8:10 a.m.

Out Of Region Speaker:

COL William James, M.D., Chief of Dermatology, Walter Reed Army Medical Center, will be speaking on "Pigmented Lesions of the Oral Mucosa," and "Hypercoagulable States".

Clinical Meeting:

All Consortium meetings are held in conjunction with a clinical meeting at which patients are presented and discussed. This year the Departments of Dermatology from the Medical College of Georgia and Eisenhower Army Medical Center in conjunction with the Augusta Dermatological Society will present patients on Sunday, September 29, 1991 at the MCG Faculty Clinic on Harper Street. The exact location will be announced at the meeting. Registration will begin at 8:00 a.m. and patient presentations will begin at 8:30 a.m. The discussion

of the patients will start at 10:00 a.m. at the Alumni Center on 15th Street.

Credit:

The American Academy of Dermatology, as an organization accredited for continuing medical education, certifies that participation in the Consortium Program plus the Clinical Meeting qualifies for 12 hours of CME credit with the American Academy of Dermatology toward the continuing medical education award and toward the Physician's Recognition Award.
